- Enable delivery of 1,000+ new town centre homes
- Deliver 7,000 extra jobs


















Manor Royal - Update

- MR Cycle Network Improvements Detailed design work for Gatwick Road, Fleming Way, Manor Royal and from Three Bridges station Detailed design options for next meeting
- "Gateway 1" Public realm enhancements upgrade key gateway into Manor Royal Work
 starts on site before end of the month.
- Highways improvements to Gatwick Road –
 Manor Royal / Fleming Way junctions Developer intends delivery from spring '19
- Manor Royal Bus Lane / Bus shelters / Super hubs – Bus Lane draft feasibility work completed end July. Options Paper awaited
- Manor Royal Outdoor Media Roll out of digital signs – Planning permission secured; Installation Autumn this year

- Reserved Matters pre-app meetings with LPA


Eastern Gateway

Three Bridges Station Corridor

- Three Bridges Station Improvement Scheme
 - Traffic modelling work to determine viability of alternatives to removing right hand turn out of station
- Detailed designs for station forecourt / E. Access underway
- Acquisition of land to enable new bus shelter at station
- Worth Park Avenue Cycle Way scheme
- Work largely complete and Cycle route up and running.
- Haslett Avenue East Signal Upgrades
- All works on traffic signals / pedestrian crossings completed
- Bus stop Super hub shelters
- Design options being worked up (Allen Scott)



TC Regeneration Site Updates

Town Hall

- Planning permission for 9 storey Town Hall building, including 5 floors of Grade A commercial space
- Outline permission for 182 flats and full permission for 91 flats on adjacent West Rock car park site.
- District Energy Centre at Planning Committee Nov '18
- Demolition of Council chamber etc autumn 2019
- Completion of new Town Hall autumn 2021

 Reserved Matters application for scale, layout, landscaping, appearance and access – 2018-19

Telford Place

- Clarion Housing Group selected by CBC
- Will develop 313 residential units, commercial space
- Planning application expected in the spring
